

Riding Break in Beautiful Berkshire



Itinerary

Day One

Arrive late afternoon and settle into your on-site accommodation, the local pubs and restaurants are just a 5 or 10 minute drive, those who choose to stay in the self catering accommodation may of course, bring their own food and wine.

Day Two

A generous breakfast will be served in the farmhouse this morning. You will then meet your horse for an assessment lesson, followed by a walkabout around the farm tracks and woodlands or on a hack around the estate (subject to the assessment). Riders may only walk and trot in open countryside on their first day with us, cantering may be permitted in the arena. A light lunch (sandwiches etc) is included today and can be ordered at breakfast, it will be served in the drawing room/garden or by the swimming pool. In the afternoon you are welcome to ride again for an hour. The evening is free to enjoy the area and local pubs/restaurants.



Day Three

After breakfast, you will have a lesson in the arena, followed by a second walkabout/hack depending on your level of riding. A three course lunch will then be served either in the dining room or by the swimming pool.



Accommodation

This wonderful estate is the sort of place where time has stood still, set in around 400 acres that includes a picturesque valley, traditional woodland and glorious walks. There is a choice of accommodation either in the large 18th century farmhouse that offers cosy rooms and delicious home cooked food or for those wanting more independence and privacy there is a choice of small stable mews self catering cottages. In the grounds there is a heated outdoor pool (free use by arrangement) beautiful traditional gardens and old fashioned flower beds. The horse riding offered is suitable for everyone including beginners. There is a maximum weight of 14 stone. The holidays and short breaks are also suitable for non riders. The accommodation is non-smoking.



Prices

The cost for 2 night's accommodation on B&B basis and 4 riding opportunities is £315 per adult, £275 per child (12 years and under) and for non riders £125pp. Single supplement of £20 per night.
