

Dressage Break, Cheshire



Itinerary

Day One

Arrive today and settle in to your accommodation. If time permits we can organise a lesson for you or if not riding will start tomorrow. This evening you have a host of local restaurants and pubs to choose from, all within a few minutes drive (and one within walking distance). This evening you can choose again from a range of dining experiences in the pretty village of Tarporley; The Rising Sun is renowned for exquisite food and Cristiano's is one of the best Italian's in Cheshire.



Day Two

After breakfast you will be heading to the riding centre for your first lesson on their quality dressage horses. After a quick assessment you will be allocated your horse and you will then be taught by one of the stable's BHS Approved Instructors. The riding centre offers top quality facilities and has both outdoor and indoor arenas. Lunch may be taken in the form of a bar snack at the adjacent hotel or at a local pub just minutes away. This afternoon you will be enjoying a second dressage lesson. The owner of the riding centre is an active dressage competitor and you will be riding a variety of her dressage horses that are currently competing from novice to Grand Prix level.



Day Three

After breakfast in the farm house you will be heading back to the riding centre. Today's dressage lessons will give you the opportunity to practice a variety of different skills and paces to help you perfect your riding. This afternoon you will be offered a dressage lesson where you will be able to tell your instructor which area of the discipline you would like to concentrate on. For non-riding companions the historic city of Chester is only a 15 minute drive away; its unique black and white Tudor-style shopping rows draw visitors from around the globe.
